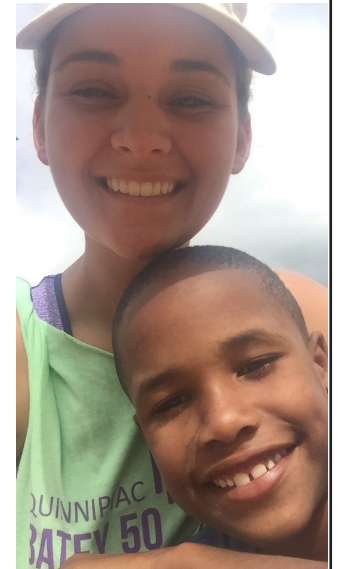


# Honoring Corey Burke: Batey 50, Dominican Republic



## **Honoring the Memory of Corey Burke**

From December 28, 2015 to January 5, 2016, Corey spent a week helping the "poorest of the poor" in the Dominican Republic with a class from Quinnipiac University. Most of her time that week was spent with the people of Batey 50, a very poor and isolated Haitian sugarcane village in the DR. While there, Corey worked with her classmates to build a new home for a family, delivered tons of food to the hungry on New Year's Day, and loved on the beautiful children caught in desperate poverty.

Her family has described this experience as the most meaningful of her life, and would like to honor her memory by blessing the children and families of this village as a lasting legacy to Corey.
